[NODA ISSAI] [KOKURYU FUJI] [ISSAI FUJI]

Color: Deep Purple
Flower tassel: 40-50cm
Flower characteristics: Strong and good with flowers
Flowers bloom from a young tree

[KYUSHAKU FUJI]

Color: Blueish Purple
Flower tassel: 100-200cm

[TAKAYAMAHAKURYU]

Color: Ivory white
Flower tassel: 30-60cm
Flower characteristics: Century of petal is dark yellow
Strong and good with flowers

[YAEKOKURYU] [BOTAN FUJI]

Color: Reddish Purple
Flower tassel: 20-30cm
Flower characteristics: Double-flowered

[MURASAKIKAPITAN]

Color: Purple
Flower tassel: 10-20cm
Flower characteristics: Short tassel, Large flowered

[JAKOU]

Color: Ivory white
Flower tassel: 20-30cm
Flower characteristics: Strong fragrance
